

Mâcon Cruzille « Les Vignes de Michel »

Chardonnay

« Les Vignes de Michel » pays tribute to my father, his work and the tenacity he need to rebuild a vineyard that had disappeared. This wine, made from the first plot he planted, differs in its barrel aging, which brings it closer to a Chardonnay from the Beaune region.

Although subtle, the oaky notes underscore the intensity of a wine from a beautiful terroir.

Age of the vineyard : 43 years old

Surface : 0,70 ha

Terroir : argilo-calcareous

Altitude : 350 mètres

Exposure : west

Vinification and maturation : ½ muids (500 liters barrels) with 30% new casks during 12 months.
